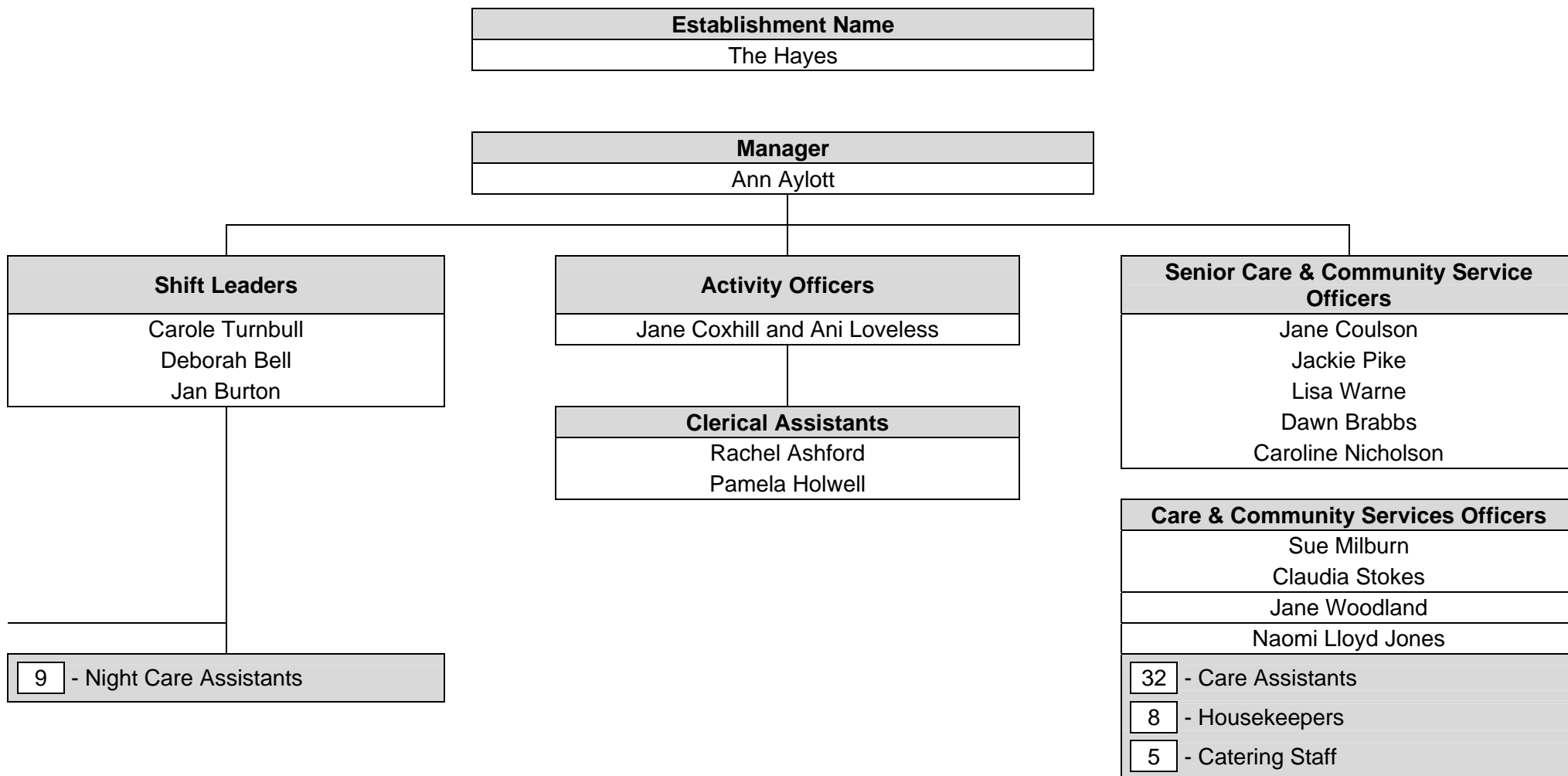

Arrangements for meeting special needs within the home:

The home promotes Person Centred Care planning and integration in every day events within the home. The activity officers employed within the home organise specific programmes for residents who may not be able to join in with other groups but, as far as possible, they are integrated into regular activities.

All hot water outlets in residents' bedrooms, communal toilets and bathrooms are fitted with thermostatically controlled washing facilities to minimise risk of residents scalding themselves.

The home has close links with the community psychiatric team who are able to advise and assist staff with regard to the care needs of residents with special needs.

The home provides level access to the grounds which include a secure garden on the west side of the building.
