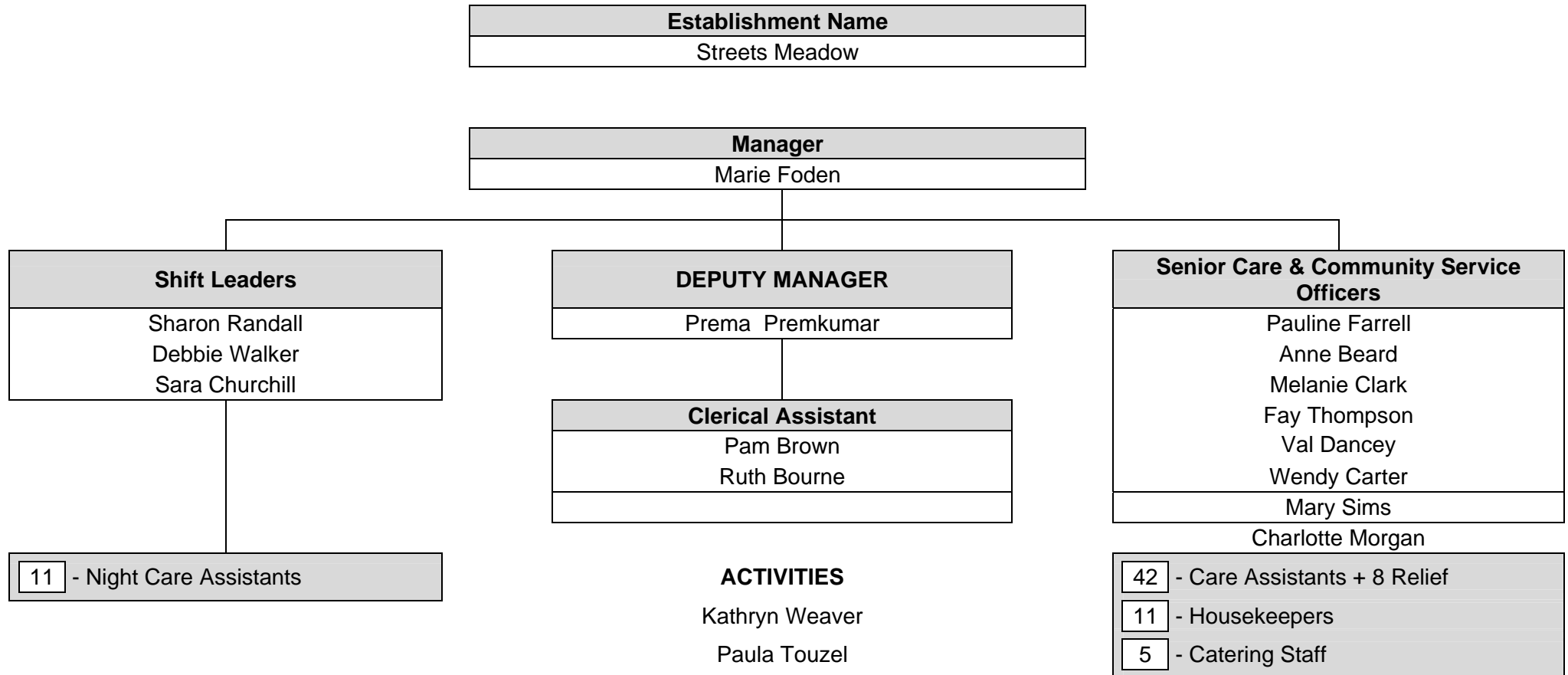

Residents are encouraged to personalise their bedrooms all of which have en-suite facilities

We have 12 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms with overhead hoists to ensure safe moving of residents

Streets Meadow has two special care units for residents suffering from a dementia

The home promotes Person Centred Care Planning and integration in every day events in the home. We have an activity officer employed within the home to organise specific programmes for residents who may not be able to join in with other groups but as far as possible we try to integrate all residents into regular activities and social groups.

All care staff attend training on dementia care as part of their induction programme and staff have opportunities for further training in this field.
